

THE CHALLENGE

The school board's mission was to consolidate the four individual buildings into one permanent 8-classroom building and have it ready for the 22-23 school year. Their goal was safety for the students and longevity on the campus. They also desired a more aesthetically appealing building to complement the site-built elementary school. The project was put out to bid for a modular building provider to work with a general contractor on the project to provide a permanent solution based on specifications given by the district and its architect.

THE SOLUTION

Mobile Modular was selected by the board for the project and we partnered with Indicom Buildings to build the 124'x64' 8-classroom building with gang restrooms. We submitted the floor plan based on the specifications provided by the district and architect. Our scope was to provide the building shell, and then work alongside the general contractor through delivery and installation. The building was equipped with custom interior and exterior finishes including matching brick and trim as well as deck and canopy systems to seamlessly blend in with the existing elementary school.
