
Project Overview

As KIPP Public Schools of Northern California expanded in Stockton, the University Park campus needed permanent-quality learning spaces to support its growing K–8 population without disrupting its mission or timeline. Enviroplex partnered with KIPP to provide five modular classrooms with integrated restrooms, designed for flexible, comfortable environments that support both academic and social-emotional learning.

A combination of vaulted and standard ceilings, oversized glazing, and extended overhangs created bright, welcoming spaces while enhancing durability and weather protection. Long-lasting exterior finishes and refined interior materials, such as stucco, LVT flooring, FRP wall panels, and custom millwork, ensured both performance and a polished look.

The result is a modern, reliable learning environment that reflects KIPP University Park's commitment to excellence, inclusivity, and community investment.





Key Building Features

- Five general-purpose classrooms and multi-fixture restrooms totaling 15,840 square feet
- Mix of vaulted ceiling buildings and standard ceiling buildings
- Extended 8' front overhangs
- Custom, oversized glazing for enhanced natural light
- Three-coat stucco exterior with plant-on fascia
- Exterior-mounted HVAC systems
- Marlite FRP interior wall panels
- Luxury vinyl tile (LVT) flooring
- Suspended steel canopies
- Custom interior millwork
- Concrete foundation
